

## **Self binding receiving blanket & burp cloth instructions**

These instructions will give you 1 receiving blanket, 4 burp cloths and about 16 - 5" squares for another charity project. Please use flannel so your project is soft and cuddly for sensitive baby skin!

### **Fabric requirement (This fabric will make ALL the projects)**

Flannel fabric A - 1 1/3 yards  
Coordinating Flannel fabric B - 1 2/3 yards

### **Self binding receiving blanket**

- Cut Fabric A - 30 x 30
- Cut Fabric B - 40 x 40
- Save remaining fabric for burp cloths and 5" squares

  - You can also do a google search on Missouri star self binding receiving blanket and it will pop up. Don't use the video on cuddle fabric unless you are using Shannon cuddle fabric (Minky)

### **Burp cloth (Cut out 4)**

- Layout the remaining fabric A & fabric B with right sides together.
- Trace the bib pattern on the fabric, pin fabric and cut on the line
- Sew the 2 layers of fabric together leaving a 2" opening on the straight edge.
- Clip the inside curves and then turn the fabric right sides out thru the opening.
- Iron flat and then top stitch the whole burp cloth.

### **5" squares**

- With the left over fabric cut them in 5" squares and place in a baggie for a later project
