## 2020/2021 TBQ Scrappy Mystery BOM Sampler Quilt Part 2 - September 2020


This month we will continue to sew 4 patch filler blocks from August and sew **6** - 6" (6½" unfinished) Churn Dash blocks.

Cutting instructions for one block:

Two 2 1/8" squares of the accent 1 fabric

Two 2  $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and one 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square of background fabric One 10" by 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip each of accent 2 and the background fabric.

(Or you may cut four 2 ½" by 1 ½" rectangles each fabric)



If you decided to cut the 10" by 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips, put them right sides together and sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance. Then cut into four 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " segments.

If you decided to cut them as 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " by 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " segments, sew them together into 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.



HST's (half square triangles) Carefully draw a line corner to corner, (diagonally) through the 2 ½" background squares. This will be a cutting line when you are finished. Place accent 1 and background 2 ½" squares right sides together. If you have a true 1/4 inch foot on your machine, you can sew on either side of the drawn line.

If not, you will have to draw a second line on either side, exactly 1/4 inch from the first line. They will be your sewing lines. After you have sewn on your sewing lines, 1/4 inch on either side of your corner to corner to line, you will cut this square in half on the drawn cutting line. Clip off the corners as shown.

You will now have two triangle squares, which should measure exactly 2 1/2 inches. You need four for this block.
















Then assemble your Churn Dash block like this.
