

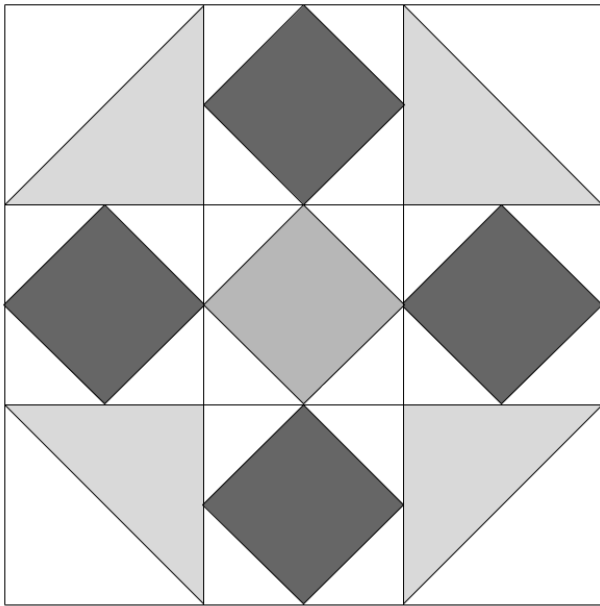
2020/2021 TBQ Scrappy Mystery BOM Sampler Quilt

Part 8 - March 2021

We only have one block to make this month. I thought we were done making blocks but, as I was putting all of my blocks up on the design wall I discovered that there was a bit of a blank spot in the quilt. My calculations were a bit off so we need one more 12" block to finish the quilt.

I'm not sure what this one is called (maybe sawtooth patchwork according to one book I have). It's basically a nine patch with 4 HST's in the corners and 5 square in a square's in the other positions.

12" finished (12 1/2" unfinished) - Make 1



There are many ways to make the subunits of this block. Feel free to use your favorite method. The cutting instructions listed here are for conventional piecing.

Cutting

For HST's - Cut 2

4 7/8" squares background

4 7/8" squares contrast

Cut each square diagonally to make 4 triangles of each color

For square in a square's, Cut

10 - 2 7/8" squares background

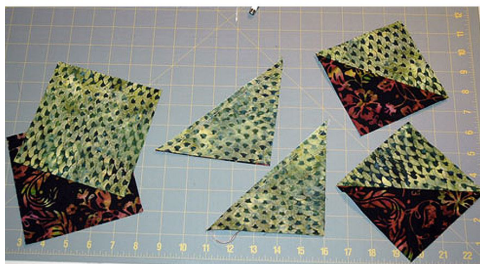
Cut each diagonally to make 20 triangles

4 - 3 3/8" squares contrast for outer squares

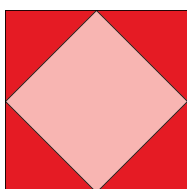
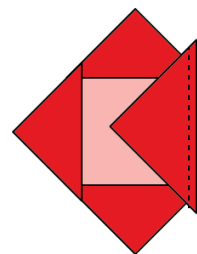
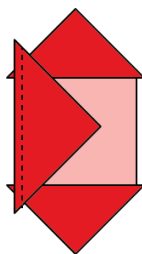
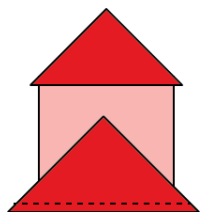
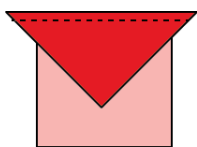
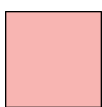
1 - 3 3/8" square contrast for center square

Sew

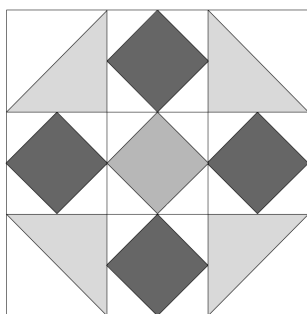
4 HST's



5 Square in a square's (4 for outer squares, 1 for center square)



Assemble 9 patch per diagram
