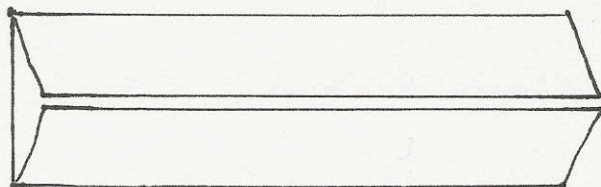
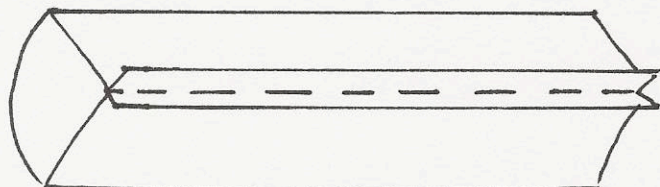


To Construct A Quilt Sleeve

- Cut a piece of fabric 9" X the width of your quilt.
- Fold the two long sides to the center to touching with "right sides" out.



- Press a firm crease on both sides.
- Bring the raw edges "wrong sides" together and sew a $\frac{1}{2}$ " seam the length.



- Press the seam.
- Lay the sleeve on your quilt back seam side down.
- Sew the sleeve to the quilt on the folded edges.
- There will be a bulge for the quilt rack pole.
