## February/March 2022 Block of the Month

Raw edge Bulls Eye Block

Materials: for 1 block

Background - White or a white on white print (not cream or off white) 9 ½" square

Circles - 3 coordinating colors (use blues and yellows spring) for each block

Please make 4 blocks (use 12 different fabrics, 6 - blues and 6 - yellows)

Step #1- Cut out 4 solid white squares 9 ½"x 9 ½"



Step #2. Cut out your circles. You will need a small - approx. 4", a medium - approx. 5 ½", and large - approx. 7" circle for each square. That means 12 in total for 4 blocks



So

Step #3. Center a large circle on one of your squares (pin it if you like) and sew it on. Just like that. Your stitch line will be about 1/4 of an inch inside your circle and you will have raw edges. (These will fray and get softer the more the quilt is washed.)



Step #4. Center your medium circle in the middle of your large circle (pin if you like) and sew it on just like you did the large circle. Easy.



Step #5. Center your smallest circle in the middle of your medium circle (pin it if you like) and sew it on exactly the way you did the other two circles. Now repeat the process 4 more times.



Step #6. Please bring your block to April's meeting whole.

The winner will get to take them home and cut them vertically and horizontally and reassemble the quarter square blocks as they like as shown here.
