
April 2022 Block of the Month

Poppy block



Sometimes called Posy, Poppy, or Violet, this month's block is very popular on the internet. The piecing diagrams are from the <u>CluckCluckSew.com</u>

For each 10" finished, 10 1/2" unfinished block cut:

Flower fabric (use any color you like. You can also use 4 different prints of the same color if you like)

4 - 5 1/2" squares

Centers

4 - 2" contrasting color squares

Background

8 - 2 ½" white squares, (please use a solid white - not cream or off white)

Please note that the center square in these diagrams is larger than the one we are making.

Referring to diagrams below, draw a diagonal line on each of the white and contrasting center squares.

Snowball two white squares onto two corners of each flower square. Snowball on center square onto third corner, as shown below. (Be careful with placement) Sew on the drawn line. Trim the corners leaving 1/4", and press the corners out. Repeat with remaining squares

Stitch four flower squares together to create one poppy block. The block should measure 10 1/2" square.
