## August 2022 Block of the Month

## **Circle of Squares**

This month's block of the month comes from the blog Toefeather.blogspot.com <u>circle-of-squares-block-information.htm</u>l



Please use a **white or near white background** so that the blocks coordinate with one another. I used 8 different values of the same color from my scrap bin to create my sample.

Here are the cutting measurements I used to make a 12" (12 1/2" unfinished) block.

You will need four units like this which are made up of 2 ½" squares. Once the squares are sewn together, the unit measures 4 ½" square.

If the picture is blurry it says 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares and 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " units

If the picture is blurry it says 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" square bordered by 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips on all sides

The unit measures 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ ". You will need one 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square for the center. Now you have nine 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares
