## April/May 2023 Block of the Month

## Scrappy Bear Claw

This month's block of the month is inspired by the many scrappy bear paw quilts I saw on the internet. It's $1 / 4$ of a full Bears' Paw block. It will be fun to see how the recipient of these blocks combines them into a quilt.


This is a $4 \times 4$ patch block combining a nine patch and half square triangles to yield a 12 " finished ( $121 / 2$ " unfinished block). Try to use solids or fabrics that read as solids. I use 6 solid colors in my sample but you can use as many colors as you like.

## Cutting

| Fabric | Number | Size |
| :---: | :---: | :---: |
| A | 1 | $3 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| A | 3 | $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| B, C, D | 1 of each color $(3$ total $)$ | $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| E | 5 | $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |
| F | 4 | $31 / 2 " \times 31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ |

Sew 6-1/2 square triangles (Fabrics A,B,C,D)
Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the Fabric A $411 / 2$ " squares

Layer each Fabric A with a B, a C, and a D square Sew $1 / 4$ " away from both sides of the drawn line Cut apart along the drawn diagonal line


Trim $1 / 2$ square triangles to $31 / 2$ " square

Layout and sew the squares and $1 / 2$ square triangles together as shown below:
