
# August/September 2023 Block of the Month

# Boo!

This month's block is adapted from a Sassafras Lane free pattern. I have changed the piecing directions to make the block easier and faster to sew.



The finished block size is 8" x 11" (8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 11  $\frac{1}{2}$ " unfinished). Use a fun halloween colored (orange, purple, green, etc.) tone on tone fabric for background, a white tone on tone fabric for the ghost, and black for the eyes.

### Cutting

### Sewing instructions

## Top row of ghost

Sew the two  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " background squares to the ends of the  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " white rectangle (sew and flip style)



#### Eye row

Sew the two 1" x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " black rectangles to the  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white square. Sew the two  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangles to either side of eyes

#### Bottom row of ghost

Make three - Sew two  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " white squares to the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangle (sew and flip style) to make a flying geese.

Sew three geese blocks together

Ghost

Referring to diagram sew the ghost body together in rows

#### **Borders**

Add the top and bottom 6  $\frac{1}{2}$  x 1/1/2" background rectangles

Add the side 11  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " background rectangles

Block should measure 8 1/2" x 11 1/2"
