## December/January 2024 Block of the Month

Did you know that National Umbrella Day is coming up on February 10t?. This month's block celebrates the day and is adapted from a free pattern from Kelli Fannin whose fun website has over 100 national day quilt block tutorials. Check it out <a href="https://example.com/here.">here.</a>

The finished block size is  $8" \times 8" (8\frac{1}{2}" \times 8\frac{1}{2}" \text{ unfinished})$ . Use 2 or more fun fabrics for the umbrella, a dark for the handle and a light neutral for the background. It's super easy, so you'll want to make a few.




## Cutting

Fabric	Number to cut	Size to cut	Other instructions
Background	1	1" x 1" square	
	1	1 ½" x 3 ½" rectangle	
	2	2 ½" x 2 ½" square	Draw a diagonal line on wrong side
	1	3 ½" x 4 ½" rectangle	
	1	4" x 4 ½" rectangle	
Umbrella stripe A	2	1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle	
Umbrella stripe B	2	1 ½" x 8 ½" rectangle	
Handle	1	1" x 1" square	
	1	1" x 1 ½" rectangle	
	1	1" x 4 ½" rectangle	

## Sewing

Sew umbrella rectangles together to make a strip set.



Place a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " square on each corner of the strip set. Sew on previously drawn diagonal line (snowball style). Trim, flip, and press.



## Assemble as shown
