

May/June 2024 Block of the Month

This Block of the Month is inspired by a quilt found online at the Patchwork Sampler site [here](#). This quilt is made from a super simple block I've drafted for our use. The finished block measures 6" x 6" (6½" x 6½" unfinished). Make your blocks scrappy using a variety of red, white, and blue fabrics. **Be careful to follow the diagram for color placement.** The block is super easy, so you'll want to make a few.



Cutting

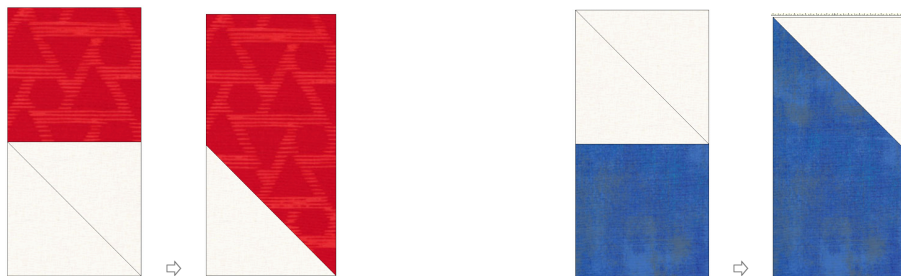
Fabric	Number to cut	Size to cut
Red print	1	3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle
White print	2	3 ½" square
Blue print	1	3 ½" x 6 ½" rectangle

Sewing

¼" seam allowance unless otherwise noted.

Mark a diagonal line from corner to corner on each white square.

With right sides together, place white square on each rectangle as shown. Sew on the drawn line. Flip and press square to rectangle snowball style. Trim seam allowance to ¼".



Sew blue and red rectangles together as shown. Press seam to blue rectangle.
