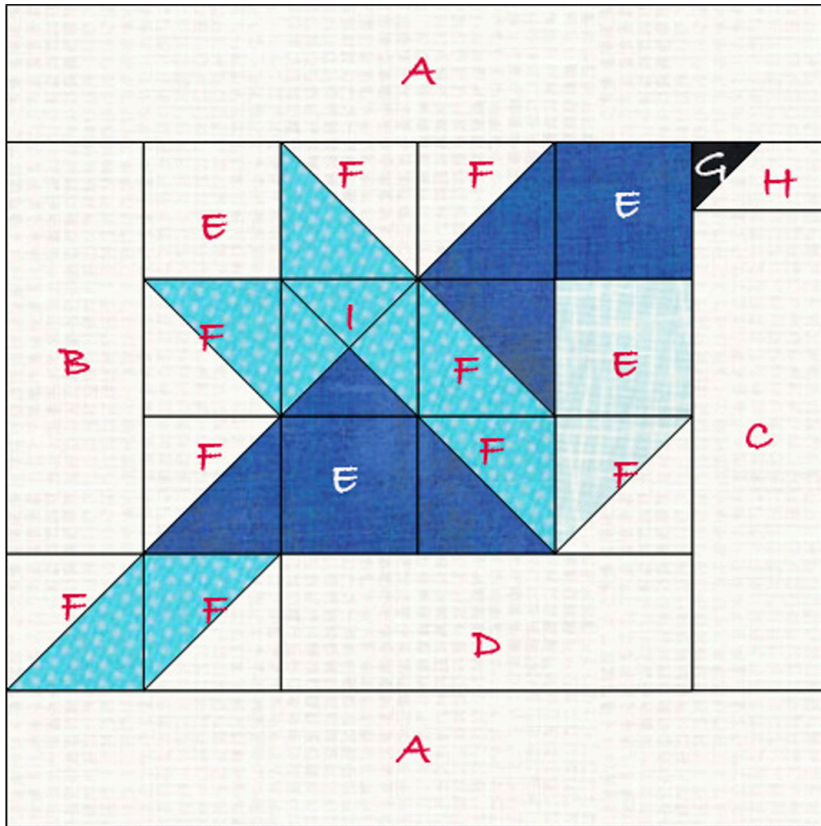


January Block of the Month



What will be the color of your bird?
Be creative

Background - Cut

- 2 - 2.5 x 12.5 (A)
- 2 - 6.5 x 2.5 (B/D)
- 1 - 7.5 x 2.5 (C)
- 8 - 2.5" square (E/F)
- 1 - 1.5 x 2.5 (H)

Light - Cut

- 2 - 2.5" square (E/F)

Medium - Cut

- 6 - 2.5" squares (F)
- 1 - 3 1/4" square (I)

Dark - Cut

- 6 - 2.5" squares (E/F)
- 1 - 3 1/4" square (I)

Black - Cut

- 1 - 1.5" square (G)

MAKE -

1. Snowball black square onto corner of bkgrnd rectangle (H)
trim to 1/4" seam allowance press to black
2. 4 hst bkgrnd/medium (F)- 2 hst bkgrnd/dark (F) 1 hst bkgrnd/light (F)
2 hst medium/dark (F) - trim to 1/4" seam allowance - press to dark
3. Make 1 quarter sq. triangle (I) - layer the medium and dark 3 1/4" squares right sides together and cut once diagonally. Separate one triangle set and set aside the dark triangle. With the other triangle set cut diagonally from squared corner to center of bias cut. On one set sew a 1/4" seam on the line you just cut and set aside the other set - this will give you the lower triangle set of section I. Press with seam to dark side and sew to the larger medium triangle. Trim to 2.5" square. You will have one medium single triangle and one smaller triangle set left - save these for another bird block.
