

Wonky Log Cabin Quilt Workshop with Rob Appell



This will be a fun and fluid workshop building log cabin blocks that are intentionally less than perfect, aka Wonky Blocks. This workshop is a great way to work through your scraps or is perfect for that 2 1/2" pre-cut strip bundle. I suggest using prints that are not so busy and read more as solids so that the strips stand out. There is no required finished size, or set amount of blocks, it can be sewers choice. I will complete the workshop by teaching how to fit the random blocks together. Supply List

- Regular sewing tools
 - Sewing machine
 - 45mm rotary cutter
 - Cutting mat
 - A ruler or two for making strips
- * Optional:
Ruby Beholder or value finder.

Fabrics Needed

- 1/4 Yard of about 10-20 different fabrics
- OR a 2 1/2" pre-cut strip bundle, or fat quarter bundle

Rob suggests prints that are not so busy, more reading as solids, so that the strips may stand out.
