

BOM for September, 2026

9.5 inch square CAT block (From Missouri Star Quilt Company tutorial)

1. Using a printed fabric, cut 5" x 9 1/2" block for the body. Cut 3" x 5" for the head. Cut 2 - 2 1/2 " squares for the ears.
2. From the neutral background, cut a 5" square.
Cut 5" x 2 1/2" for the ears.
Cut one 2 1/2" square to add to the body.
3. Draw a diagonal line on the background square and sew it to the top RIGHT corner of the body. Trim and press.
4. Using printed fabric, make a flying geese type (they won't actually overlap but that's OK) on the neutral piece for the ears.
5. Sew the ear portion to the head portion, making sure that the colorful fabric ears point up.
6. Sew the head to the neutral 5" square body and add that to the rest of the cat.
7. Trim to 9 1/2" square.

Optional: Make the same cat facing the opposite direction by sewing the neutral square to the LEFT side of the body, the head on the right side and completing the cat the same way.
